A BILL

To provide that the inclusion of the gray wolf on lists of endangered species and threatened species under the Endangered Species Act of 1973 shall have no force or effect.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “State Sovereignty
5 Wildlife Management Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. STATUS OF GRAY WOLF AS ENDANGERED SPECIES**
2 **OR THREATENED SPECIES.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law (includ-
4 ing regulations), the inclusion of the gray wolf (*Canis*
5 *lupus*) (including any gray wolf designated as “non-
6 essential experimental”) on any list of endangered species
7 or threatened species under section 4(c)(1) of the Endan-
8 gered Species Act of 1973 (7 U.S.C. 1533(c)(1)) shall
9 have no force or effect.
